2010-2011 REQUEST TO RESTRICT DIRECTORY INFORMATION

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) designates certain information related to students as "Directory Information" and gives the Academy the right to disclose such information to anyone inquiring without having to ask the students for permission, unless the students specifically request in writing that all such information not be made public without their written consent. If, however, you wish to withhold the disclosure of all of the items of directory information, fill out the information below and return this form to the Office of the Registrar and Financial Aid. By submitting this form you will restrict the release of directory information. This means that (except as otherwise allowed by law) NO directory information will be disclosed about you to persons or organizations not affiliated with NYFA, including degrees awarded, while the restriction is in effect. Also, any request to restrict Directory Information will not apply to any specific information release authorization you provide to a Academy official.
